## GARBAGE AND RECYCLING INFORMATION

Questions concerning recycling, please call the Village of Falconer at 665-4400 or Casella at 483-5128 between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm. Note: Household garbage and recyclables should be placed in a container at the curb the evening prior to the scheduled day of collection. **LIMIT: THREE (3) 30-GALLON BAGS PER HOUSEHOLD.** The following items will NOT be picked up: discarded clothing, toys, furniture, appliances, any wood or yard waste, brush, TV or computer monitors, batteries, tires, liquid waste, scrap steel, carpet and construction waste. The Chautauqua County Transfer Station on S. Work Street, Falconer, can be reached at 665-6894 for information on disposal. Please do not put recyclables in plastic bags; place in rigid container.

Zero-Sort® Recycling is collected at your curb every week. Simply place all acceptable items into your **Marked Recycling Container.**

## ACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR RECYCLING:

All items must be clean & residue free.

Cardboard: cereal boxes, pasta boxes, shoe boxes

Paper: newspapers, junk mail, envelopes, catalogs, soft cover books, telephone books, brown bags, magazines and inserts

Plastic: containers #1 - #7 (milk jugs, bleach, detergent, shampoo bottles)

Glass: bottles and containers (any color)

Cans: aluminum, tin, steel containers (pie plates/trays/foil)

(Nothing with chemicals previously in them)

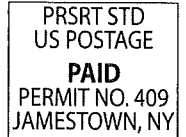

## BRUSH DISPOSAL SCHEDULE

Disposal of leaves, brush, twigs, trimmings and grass clippings will be accepted beginning Tuesday, April 16, 2018, and every other Tuesday thereafter until Tuesday, October 1, at the Village of Falconer Highway Garage, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. **ONLY BIODEGRADABLE MATERIALS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Maximum of one cubic yard per vehicle. Example: One pickup truck at water level full. No bags, boxes or any other containers will be accepted. **PERMITS WILL BE REQUIRED.** All Village of Falconer residents can pick up permits at: Village Clerk's Office, 101 W. Main Street, Falconer, NY, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

You no longer have to separate your paper materials and cardboard from your tin, and plastic. Simply place all acceptable items into your **MARKED RECYCLING CONTAINER**

## ACCEPTABLE: IN RECYCLING CONTAINER

- Cardboard
- Clean boxboard (shoe boxes; cereal boxes)
- Office Paper (white and colored)
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Junk Mail
- Envelopes (manila and regular)
- File Folders
- Computer Paper
- Post IT Notes
- Card Stock Paper
- Aluminum Cans
- Tin Cans
- Plastic Bottles  
(clear plastic water bottles & juice, milk jugs. Nothing with chemicals previously in them.)

## NOT ACCEPTABLE: IN RECYCLING CONTAINER

- Food Waste
- Styrofoam
- Plastic Bags
- Printer Cartridges (toner or inkjet)
- Cell phones
- Batteries
- Computers or other electronics
- Glassware or glass of any kind
- Colored plastic
- Rigid Plastic (Laundry Baskets, Pails, etc.)
