GARBAGE WILL BE PICKED UP ON TUESDAY

EXCEPT FOR JULY 5, 2017

Questions concerning recycling, please call 487-4175. Please note: household recyclables and garbage should be placed in a container at the curb the evening prior to the scheduled day of collection. Garbage and recyclables are prohibited to be brought in and deposited by any person outside the village (**non-residents**).

Each person shall provide separate galvanized iron cans or other suitable sanitary containers for garbage and non-recyclable rubbish only. Such cans or containers shall not exceed twenty (20) gallon capacity and when filled shall not exceed sixty (60) pounds in weight with a maximum of six (6) bags per residence.

All recyclables are to be placed in a plastic container or a galvanized iron can or other suitable container.

Animal waste should be double-bagged with a quantity that can be easily handled by one person without breakage or spillage of the bag.

As of January, 2010 the landfill WILL NOT accept any electronics nor are we able to collect them. Electronics are (but not limited to) TV's, VCR's, Computers, etc.

You may contact the Chautauqua County Landfill for proper disposal of electronics, tires and hazardous wastes.

Red Week

Metal cans
rinse clean, remove paper labels

Green Week

Newspaper & magazines, place in covered, rigid receptacle.

Corrugated cardboard MUST be flattened.

Note: Do not place newspapers, magazines, or cardboard in plastic bags.

Note: No hardboard or pizza boxes

Blue Week

Soft Plastic 1-5
Plastic jugs, such as milk
juice containers, and laundry
detergent, rinse out

Note: Hard plastic and motor
oil are not recyclable. Place in
regular garbage.

Yellow Week

Glass jars & bottles (clear glass only)
rinse clean, labels do not need to be
removed.

Note: No light bulbs, windows,
mirrors, dishes, or glasses
in regular garbage.

*****Syringe disposal:** syringes may be taken to the Security Officer's Desk at the Emergency Entrance of the WCA Hospital, Monday through Saturday between 7am-3pm. Syringes must be in a closed clear plastic container (milk or pop containers).
