Supervisor McLaughlin reported that he has met twice with representatives from *Cornell Cooperative Extension* re their interest in leasing the vacant office space on the first floor of the Town of Ellicott Administration Building. According to Mr. McLaughlin, the *CCE* board should have a final decision re the matter in early April 2018.

Mr. McLaughlin also reported that he and several other town officers will be meeting this Wednesday with *Jamestown Board of Public Utilities* officials to continue negotiations re a new water and sewer agreement with the *City of Jamestown*. (Minutes 8/21/17 et. seq.)
